Arriving by Car

From London take the A10 northbound and turn off at the junction marked 'Ware (B1001)'. Turn right on to the B1001 towards the town centre. Turn right at the roundabout at the bottom of the hill on to Park Road and continue on until you reach the main gate on the left. Do not turn into Buryfield Way which is signposted GSK.

Arriving by Air

Ware is 15 miles from Stansted Airport and 50 miles from Heathrow Airport.

Arriving by Train

Ware Station is approximately 1 mile from the Ware site. Trains run from London Liverpool Street to Hertford East via Tottenham Hale (underground connection).

Site instructions

EXHIBITORS : Set-up / Break-down

- On arrival go to the **Contractors Entrance on Harris's Lane**. Go to the Security Officer and obtain a Contractors Pass for yourself / your vehicle.
- Then exit the site at the Contractors Entrance on Harris's Lane and drive to the **Main Entrance on Park Road** to enter the site in your vehicle.
- On arrival at Main Entrance you must show your Contractor Pass to the Security Officer who will direct you to Building 8 (the Conference Centre) and the turning circle where you can park to unload.
- After unloading, PLEASE remove your vehicle from the middle of the site and **park up in the Contractors Car Park on Harris's Lane**.
- Exhibitors must display their Contractors Pass at all times whilst on site.
- Contractors Pass to be returned to Security Office before leaving the site.

Delegates arriving on Show Days (Wed 13th and Thur 14th) :

Please park in the **Contractors Car Park on Harris Lane** and you will be guided directly across to the Conference Centre. ELRIG conference badges are sufficient for these times, be must be worn, please.
